PREPARATION FOR THE SACRAMENTS OF RECONCILIATION,  
EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION

### Our **Parish Religious Education Program (PREP)**

is offered for Parish children who  
do not attend a Catholic School.

These children must attend weekly classes for  
10 weeks on

Wednesday afternoons from 4.00 – 5.00pm  
to receive the necessary instruction to prepare  
them for the Sacrament they will be receiving.

**Enrolments for these classes close  
on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2024.**

Completed Sacramental Program Enrolment Forms,  
copies of previous sacramental certificates and  
accompanying money must be received before then.

**PREP Classes will commence on  
Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> February from 4.00pm – 5.00pm**

in the Parish Centre, located at the rear of  
47 Peebles Rd, Floreat.

Children must attend **all** classes.

### **Parish Children who attend a Catholic School**

will receive instruction at their school as part of their  
Religious Education Program.

However, in order to receive the Sacraments, they  
must **still enrol with the Parish.**

Completed Enrolment Forms and accompanying  
money **must be received by  
Friday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2024**

In the event that a child in a Catholic School  
has missed the preparation for a particular  
Sacrament, they are invited to join the  
PREP.

According to our Archdiocesan Guidelines, children are  
prepared to receive the Sacraments as follows:

- \* Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation) in Year 3
- \* Sacrament of Eucharist (First Communion) in Year 4
- \* Sacrament of Confirmation in Year 6.

In order to maintain the uniqueness of each,  
only one Sacrament should be received each year  
under this Program.

“Parish” refers to where you live (Parish Boundaries),  
where you worship and are registered as a parishioner.

## PLEASE TAKE NOTE:

### KEY DATES

When enrolling your child, **please ensure to provide us with your CHOSEN DATES for the relevant events/celebrations. (These events are for ALL CANDIDATES from both Catholic and non-Catholic schools.) otherwise we will need to select the dates for you.** Please ensure to include all correct full names and contact details on the enrolment form.

Events include:

1. Parent Information Night *(N.B. One evening, for parents/guardians only)*
2. Commitment Mass
3. Parent & Child Workshop
4. Reconciliation (before First Holy Communion or Confirmation)
5. Rehearsal of the Celebration of the Sacrament.
6. Celebration of the Sacrament (Reconciliation, First Holy Communion or Confirmation)

### SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATIONS

We do **NOT** have a **professional photographer** at our celebrations.

You are welcome to take your own photographs before and after the ceremony. However, to maintain a reverent atmosphere, we ask that **no photos or videos are taken during the Mass or celebration of the Sacrament.** Please also inform your guests of this request.

Full group photos can be taken after children have received their Sacramental Certificates, under the direction of Fr Kaz. If you would like your child to have a photograph with Fr Kaz, he will also be happy to oblige after Mass.

### Dress requirements (especially for First Holy Communion)

Our normal dress code is "Sunday best" or smart attire. Some celebrations (especially First Holy Communion) can be surrounded by tradition, depending on cultural heritage. Our parish provides this guide:

- Girls - Best dress, long or short, and traditionally white. Veils are not recommended as they are awkward if not attached securely. If head decoration is required, a spray of small flowers, a hair comb or clip is more practical.
- Boys - Smart, neat clothes. A collared shirt with smart trousers is sufficient, however, you can also add a tie, jumper, jacket or vest.

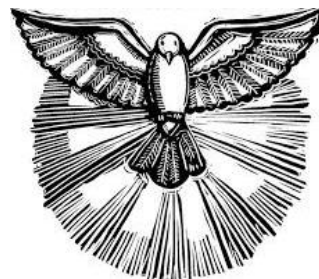

## DUTY OF CARE STATEMENT & PRIVACY POLICY

### **FOR PARISH PREPARED (PREP) STUDENT ONLY:**

The parish of FLOREAT WEMBLEY has a Duty of Care to children attending the after-school Parish Religious Education Program (PREP). Your child(ren)'s safety and wellbeing are of utmost importance to us. While with us, they will be in the care of responsible adults who have undergone a 'Working with Children' check. Our parish catechists are dedicated volunteers with many years' experience. Please remember that they also have families or other commitments after classes, and we thank you for your cooperation and support in adhering to the following;

- PREP classes are held during Terms 1 and 2 on Wednesday afternoons from 4.00pm – 5.00pm in the Parish Hall.
- Classes are held over 10 weeks only. As the period of preparation is so short, it is **COMPULSORY** that your child attend each lesson.
- Classes start promptly at 4.00pm. PLEASE do not be late. Should your child arrive before 4.00pm and there is no catechist to supervise, it is your responsibility to supervise your child until a catechist arrives. The child must stay with you during this time.
- We ask that you collect your child/children promptly at 5.00pm.
- It is the parent's responsibility to drop off and pick up their child/children; if you are delayed in picking up your child, then you should make alternate arrangements.
- In cases of emergency, please contact the Parish Secretary or Sacramental Program Coordinator on 9387 1158.
- For reasons of safety, we ask you to enter the parking lot via PEEBLES ROAD and exit via GRANTHAM STREET.
- If your child is unable to attend a lesson, you will need to contact the Parish Secretary or Sacramental Program Coordinator on 9387 1158 or [sacramentalprogram.floreat@perthcatholic.org.au](mailto:sacramentalprogram.floreat@perthcatholic.org.au) to make arrangements for your child to make up the class.
